


Real-time, all the time

providing real-time truck performance information for our customers and dealers. That information is also monitored by the specialists working round the clock at the Volvo Uptime Center.






It begins with the truck

On board every Volvo-powered truck is the industry's most advanced telematics and real-time diagnostic system. Engine, transmission and aftertreatment performance is transmitted and reviewed through connectivity.

The fully integrated diagnostic package means there's no need for additional hardware or software purchases to manage your vehicles. That commitment to connectivity also means more time on the road, reducing diagnostic time by more than 70% for Remote Diagnostics cases.



REMOTE PROGRAMMING

Enhanced connectivity allows data to flow to the truck as well. Software and parameter updates can now be performed based on the convenience of the customer with Volvo's Remote Programming feature. Drivers simply pull over, connect to the Volvo Uptime Center, and the upgrade is done over the air in a matter of minutes. Available on all Volvo models 2018 and later equipped with Volvo Power GHG17 engines.



CERTIFIED UPTIME DEALERS

Our Certified Uptime Dealerships have dedicated bays for repairs taking less than four hours, so quick repairs don't get caught behind longer jobs. Customers receive an initial diagnostic review at check-in. If the repair can be done in under four hours, it moves to an uptime bay.

FASTER RESPONSE

Each dealer is connected on the Uptime Network and can see the performance data from your vehicle, even while it's in route for assessment. By reviewing vehicle incident reports before the truck arrives, dealer service center repair times have been cut 24%.
